| 1. | Large trumpet daffodil | - 3 stems, one variety |
| 2. | Large cupped daffodil | - 3 stems, one variety |
| 3. | Small cupped daffodil | - 3 stems, one variety |
| 4. | Multi-headed daffodil | - 3 stems, one variety |
| 5. | Miniature daffodil
(up to 40 mm across) | - 3 stems, one variety, in your own vase |
| 6. | Double-flowered daffodil | - 3 stems, one variety |
| 7. | Mixed daffodil | - 7 stems |
| 8. | Pot of 5 daffodils: "Canaliculatus" | - from October Coffee Morning |
| 9. | Any other Daffodil | - 3 stems, one variety (not classified above) |
| 10. | Tulip | - 3 stems, one variety |
| 11. | Tulip | - single stem, any variety |
| 12. | 1 Hyacinth | - grown in your own pot |
| 13. | Bulbs or corms | - 3 stems in your own vase |
| 14. | Vase of flowering shrubs | - minimum 4 stems in your own vase |
| 15. | Vase of spring flowers | - in your own vase (various or one variety) |
| 16. | Up to 3 Hellebore heads | - floating in your own bowl of water |
| 17. | Flowering plant in a pot | |
| 18. | Rhubarb - 3 Sticks | |
